The project


The Project aims to involve local community in the conservation and promotion of local cultural and natural heritage, creating initiatives of civic engagement and using the heritage as a tool for lifelong learning.

We worked together to promote transversality on the issues of equality, social cohesion, democracy and encouraging cultural diversity, exploring local heritages.

We worked to increase the skills and competences of our trainers and learners creating innovative initiatives to stimulate civic engagement and active citizenship among the local communities.

Another important objective is represented by the promotion and dissemination of the Faro Convention Values and opportunities.

We wanted to sensitize local adult communities on heritage sites in danger and promote civic actions to raise awareness among citizens and public authorities.



Activities & Results

Within the project we ran 3 international mobilities and one international conference during which we met local actors, decision makers, cultural and social organizations in order to share best practices related to the use of heritage as a tool for civic engagement and active citizenship.

Each partner designed and piloted 4 different activities in different heritage fields. During the project we met several times local communities, public authorities, social and cultural associations with the purpose to promote the Faro Convention and its values of democratic participation in the life of local heritage.

Parallel initiatives for the dissemination of the project activities and results have been run at local level, like heritage walks, guided visits, workshops, conferences.

Our main target is represented by adult learners, among them also foreigners and people in disadvantaged situation.
